

# Tuition and Fees

## Tuition

Kindergarten	Single payment	11,450

The cost to educate your child is over \$15,000 in total. The KDS subsidy is approximately \$3,600 per student and it is vital that we make every effort to bridge this gap. Should you choose to cover this subsidy your contribution will be applied towards your Annual Campaign donation and is tax deductible to the full extent of the law.

A \$50 fee is charged for late payments.

Tuition may be paid by cash, check, automatic bank debit or credit card (Mastercard, Visa or American Express). A student's place will be held only if payment is received by the payment deadline and if it is in one of the approved methods. Payment(s) must be dated as of the payment dates below.

## Fees

A one-time \$150 application fee is assessed for new students. Any re-enrolling student registering after March 1st, 2010 will be assessed this \$150 "new student fee".

An enrollment deposit of \$500 (non-refundable) is required for all students. This deposit will be deducted from the tuition balance.

A Middle School Academic Fee of \$500 is due upon registration for Grades 6-8.
